Policy Procedures

, graduate, and doctoral studies) that award academic credit (i.e. any course that appears on an official transcript issued by the University) regardless of the mode of delivery, including, but not limited to residential, online, intensive, hybrid, or off campus programs. Academic departments are responsible for ensuring that credit hours as listed for each course in the published academic catalog are awarded only for work that meets the requirements outlined in this policy.

The initial credit hour recommendation is credit hour policy and the norms of the discipline. Each course must be approved by the institutional division/college that will be delivering the course and the approval recorded in appropriate faculty body minutes.
